## Reminders

Drop off and Collection times were allocated to your child in September, please stick to these times and **do not arrive earlier** than the time that was allocated.

**Car Parking** – Please do not park in front of the Community Centre building as this is not for Pre-School use, staff there will be returning at some point, and it can block access (required at all times) & make it dangerous for parents dropping off and collecting children with the one-way system in place.

**Face Coverings:** Please ensure that when you are dropping off and collecting children that a face covering is **worn at all times**, unless you are exempt as at times staff may need to speak with you.

## Outdoor Play - Sunny Weather, Sun Hats & Cream

As we hope for some nice sunny weather, please can you ensure that your child has a suitable hat, footwear and sun cream on when they come to pre-school so that they can play safely outside.

## Spare Clothes

As we are low on spare clothes at Pre-School. Please ensure that your child has enough spare clothes in their bag (**inside a plastic bag to keep dry if the bag gets wet**) during wet weather.

## Absence

Please can we ask that you ring pre-school on the first day of your child's absence to inform us. All absences need to be logged for Derbyshire Early Years and these records are part of the requirements when we are audited.

Also, a reminder that if your child has had sickness and diarrhoea there is a **48 hour exclusion** policy from the last time they have been sick or had diarrhoea. This is so that germs are contained and not passed throughout pre-school.

## Home Learning

Children who will be transitioning to school in September, will be issued with a Homework learning pack for you to work through with them at home, please support and encourage your child at home with their homework, practicing phonics, writing their name and recognising and writing numbers. Please ensure that the pack is bought back into pre-school on the requested day to enable us to work with your child, if it is not returned on the allocated day then we cannot go through the homework with your child that day.
